**(COOMBE ROAD, EAST PARK AND FREELAND BUILDINGS, EASTVILLE WARD, CITY OF BRISTOL) AND (VILLIERS ROAD, LAWRENCE HILL WARD, CITY OF BRISTOL) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC AND CONTRA-FLOW CYCLING) (BANNERMAN ROAD, EASTON AND LAWRENCE HILL WARDS, CITY OF BRISTOL) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 201-**

The City Council of Bristol hereby gives NOTICE it proposes to make a traffic order, the effect of which would be:-

1. to introduce one way traffic with contra flow cycling working in:-
  - (a) **Coombe Road** (south easterly) from Fishponds Road to East Park;
  - (b) **East Park** (south westerly) from Coombe Road to Freeland Buildings;
  - (c) **Freeland Buildings** (north westerly) from East Park to Fishponds Road; and
  - (d) **Villiers Road** (north westerly) from Chaplin Road to Stapleton Road; and
2. to introduce prohibition of driving (except pedal cycles) in that length of **Bannerman Road** which extends from Albion Road south westwards for 30 metres.
